

I have studied Spanish language back in high school and got reacquainted with it during college. Without use, I have forgotten how to speak this beautiful language. When I saw this on promo, I immediately downloaded it. I liked the layout of the contents, with the words arranged alphabetically and spaced well leaving enough room on the page to allow me to rest my eyes. The sample sentences really help the reader learn about the language. This is highly recommended to students and travelers alike.

It's more like a dictionary of 1000 words, which sounds much less impressive. I have google translate to meet this purpose. I'm not sure what some of the good reviews are referring to. There are no "phonetic" spellings. Also, there are errors. ie page 77 gives "is" as the definition for ESTA, then proceeds to use ESTA for "this" ie. Esta es una bonita historia. Confusing. Maybe it's good if you're learning Spanish for a class, but not for conversation. And even then you might lose a few grades due to these errors.

I started reading this and even though I have a basic understanding of Spanish, it's very rusty from disuse. High school Spanish just isn't enough when you live in a state with a large Spanish population. These days, you need to learn at least a little of it, and this is an excellent way to start. The book is broken down into different sections focusing on first, the alphabet, then simple words. It helps that the pronunciations are written phonetically and that we are given examples to more easily relate them to. The way the book is broken down is easy to understand and makes it fun to learn. I will be using this book for myself as well as for my granddaughters, who are two and seven. Highly recommended!
