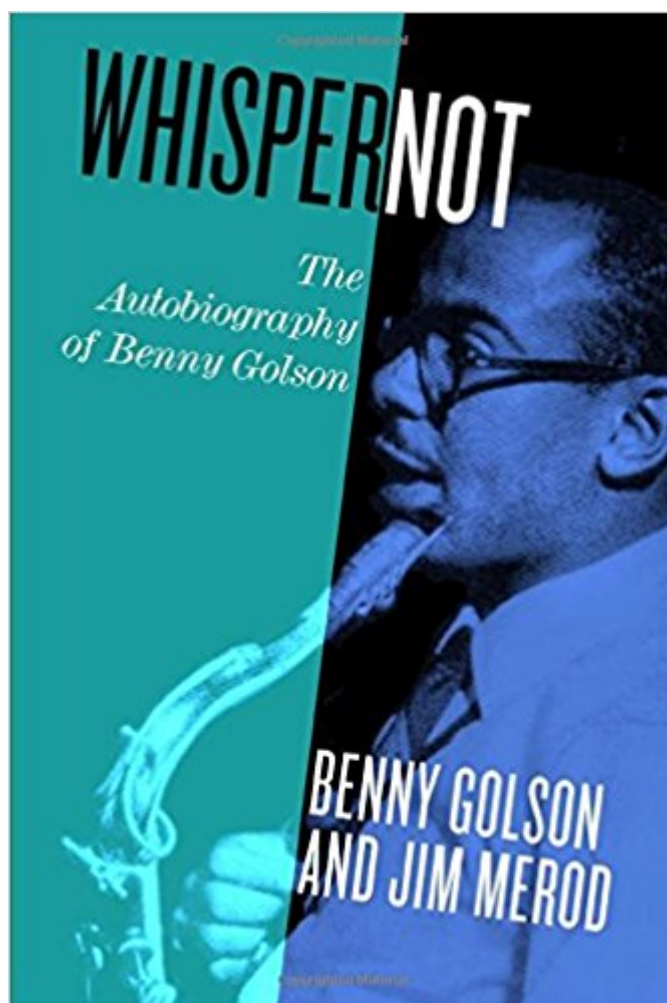

This is a long awaited book by one of the most lucid members of the golden generation of musicians who came up in the post-war boom in Jazz. Benny speaks with warmth, frankness and humor about Earl Bostic, John Coltrane, Philly Joe Jones, Tadd Dameron, Miles Davis, Art Blakey, Curtis Fuller and many others as well as his own enormous contribution to music.
